You cannot win money for this first example, but you will be able to win it for the ones that come later on. Please take time to explain this to the respondent.		
note_3ab	The example is the following: Suppose we ask 100 people in your state whether waiting 45 minutes for a taxi in the capital of the state is: a) Very socially inappropriate? b) Somewhat socially inappropriate? c) Somewhat socially appropriate? d) Very socially appropriate? What do you think the most popular answer was? Suppose 60 people say said 'b) somewhat socially inappropriate', 30 people say 'a) very socially inappropriate' and 10 people say 'c) somewhat socially appropriate'. The answer 'b) somewhat socially inappropriate' is the most popular in this example. Thus, if this game had been for real and you had answered 'b) somewhat socially inappropriate' then you would have guessed the most popular answer and won ₦ 1,000.
