<p><i>Level of presentation: India / State / District / Tahsil / Town</i>  <b>New Table in 2001 Census</b></p> <p>This table gives the distribution of households by availability of bathroom and the type of latrine within the house and the type of drainage connectivity for waste water outlet. This table excludes institutional households for which the information on availability of bathroom and type of latrine within the house and the type of drainage connectivity for waste water outlet was not collected. The facility of latrine available to the households within the house by three types viz., pit latrine, water closet and other latrine is shown in the table. Other latrines in this table includes the service latrines from where human excreta is removed by scavengers, the latrines serviced by animals such as pigs, etc. and all latrines other than the pit and the water closet types of latrine. Similarly, the number of households having drainage connectivity is further classified into closed drainage and open drainage to carry away the waste water of the household. The number of households that have no latrine and no drainage system connectivity are also presented here. The concepts of availability of bathroom and latrine within the house by types and drainage system may be seen in the chapter on Concepts and Definitions. The data in this table are presented for total, rural and urban areas separately.</p> <p>The tahsil and town level data are presented only in electronic format.</p>
